

## Messaging Guide

### Name/Tagline

#### TAGLINE

*Get the app. Stop the spread.*

- When referring to the service, use **MO/Notify** on first reference and on subsequent references.
- Never shorten the name. For example, never refer to the service as MO/N or MN.
- When referring to MO/Notify on social media, include the hashtag #MOnotify.

### Elevator Pitch

“MO/Notify is a smartphone-based COVID-19 exposure notification service. Using privacy-protecting Bluetooth technology, it lets you know if you’ve been in contact with someone who tests positive for COVID-19, even if you don’t know them. Its use is voluntary, free of charge, and can help control outbreaks in our communities.”

**MO/Notify** is a COVID-19 exposure notification service available to Apple and Android users throughout Missouri. When communicating about MO/Notify, use the language to clarify the purpose of the service and encourage its use.

### Encouraging Adoption

**Our mission is to raise awareness of MO/Notify and encourage adoption. When communicating about MO/Notify, clearly relay the benefits and importance of its use.**

#### SAMPLE MESSAGING

- Help keep our community safe. Download MO/Notify today.
- Get an alert when someone you’ve been in contact with tests positive for COVID-19, even if you don’t know them. Get MO/Notify today.
- The more people who use MO/Notify, the more we can help prevent COVID-19 outbreaks in our community.
- Use your phone to help prevent COVID-19 outbreaks. Download MO/Notify today.
- MO/Notify works with similar apps in other states to keep you aware of COVID-19 exposures when traveling.
- Stay aware with MO/Notify. Find out if you’re exposed to COVID-19 and should monitor for symptoms or get tested.
- MO/Notify is a free service that can help control COVID-19 outbreaks by alerting you if you’ve been near someone who tests positive.
- Even the vaccinated can get and spread COVID-19, often with few or no symptoms. Knowing you’ve been exposed to COVID-19 gives you the awareness to avoid spreading and harming others.

### Promoting Usage

**Our goal is to communicate MO/Notify’s ease of use. We also need to communicate to users how it works and the strong privacy protections that are in place.**

#### SAMPLE MESSAGING

- MO/Notify uses Bluetooth technology to let you know if you’ve been in contact with someone who tests positive for COVID-19.
- With MO/Notify, you can let others know if you’ve tested positive for COVID-19 without revealing your identity or your location history.
- Activate MO/Notify and turn on notifications to be alerted if someone you’ve been in close contact with tests positive for COVID-19, even if you don’t know them. Your identity is not revealed to them or the service.
- MO/Notify allows you to enable or disable exposure notifications, meaning you can opt-in or opt-out at any time.
- MO/Notify doesn’t track your location or reveal your identity. It protects your privacy while combating COVID-19 in the community.
- MO/Notify alerts you if you’ve been in contact with someone who tests positive for COVID-19. That means you can monitor for symptoms, and isolate and get tested, if needed, to avoid spreading it to others.
